


Layton Chapel Baptist Church Prayer Walk



Prayer Walk Stations

1. ADORATION and WORSHIP

Be still, and know that I am God: I will be exalted among the heathen, I will be exalted in the earth. (Psalms 46:10)

2. CONFESSION

If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. (1 John 1:9)

3. FORGIVENESS

And be ye kind one to another, tenderhearted, forgiving one another, even as God for Christ's sake hath forgiven you. (Ephesians 4:32)

4. THANKSGIVING and PRAISE

I will bless the LORD at all times: his praise shall continually be in my mouth. (Psalms 34:1)

5. SURRENDER

I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that ye present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service.

And be not conformed to this world: but be ye transformed by the renewing of your mind, that ye may prove what is that good, and acceptable, and perfect, will of God. (Romans 12:1 - 2)

6. INTERCESSION and SUPPLICATION

The eyes of the LORD are upon the righteous, and his ears are open unto their cry. (Psalms 34:15)

And this is the confidence that we have in him, that, if we ask any thing according to his will, he heareth us: (1 John 5:14)

—Praying for OTHERS

—Praying for MYSELF

7. FOLLOWING GOD'S WILL

I delight to do thy will, O my God: yea, thy law is within my heart. (Psalms 40:8)

Shew me thy ways, O LORD; teach me thy paths.

Lead me in thy truth, and teach me: for thou art the God of my salvation; on thee do I wait all the day. (Psalms 25:4 - 5)

8. CLOSER WALK WITH THE LORD

He that dwelleth in the secret place of the most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty. (Psalms 91:1)

This is a “nature” trail. Please be careful as you walk. Bugs and beasts may be around.

Please do not bring trash or litter.

The Green Trail is the Prayer walk.

The Yellow Trail is the Long Trail.

The Red Trails are optional trails or shortcuts.
